- The negative quality **in** a character that will **lead** them to make bad decisions.
- Greek New Testament → SIN (original vs actual) "In You" vs "Acted Out"
 - Most frequently Romans (45x), Hebrews (24x) Gospel of John (15x), 1 John (15x),
- Examples:
 - Achilles' anger in *The Iliad*
 - Odysseus' lust in *The Odyssey*
